From the files of the Baronial Herald:

Court was heralded by Lord Nathaniel Jonesson.

Elsebeth Ffarberyn was presented to the populace as the baronial A&S champion.

Wilhelm von Pottruff was congratulated on his birthday.

Gwendolyn of Aldburg and Joffr Rödson were congratulated for authorizing in fencing.

Marguerite Gingraix, Order of the Hare Salient, 2022

Wee speake to Our Herald, and Signet, and all of the Hare thus, Know my deare ones that this Dame Marguerite Gingraix is a personage of generosity of time and labour, and Wee have thought long about them, and Wee shall devide Our thinking into six parts. In the first what the generosity is, whiche is Service, secondly that said Service has been demonstrated by their time as Baronial Exhequer, thirdly that this Service was continued as Baronial Signet, fourthly that this Radicall gift to Us, our forebears, and Our people must and should be recognized, fifthly that We have an Order to recognize great Service, and sixtly that it be but naturall that Wee shall therefore induct Dame Marguerite into the Order of the Hare Salient.

This, in Our wisdome was done by Dubhessa and Joffr, Baroness and Baron of Skraeling Althing at the Feast of the Hare in the Canton of Calrithig on the anniversary of the crowning of Lothair III, being the twelfth day of November, in the yeare of the Society seven and fifty.

Item: Archery Competition Results and Confirmation of Archery Champion

Baron Duncan Gabha MacLAchlan MacLeod announced the results of the archery contest. Duncan was the over all winner and he was reaffirmed by Baron Joffr as the Archery Champion of Skraeling Althing.

Item: Event Staff Thanks

The event staff of Baronial Muster were thanked and given tokens.

Addendum:

Dame Siglinde was called into court in her position as Lawspeaker, but this was revealed to be subterfuge to allow her to present Colyne's Hare Salient. Colyne was completely unaware, even though he knew the Baron needed a heat source to melt sealing wax for scrolls and that none of the recipients of Colyne's court list had attended the event.

Feast of the Hare Caldrithig, Nov 12, 2022

From the files of the Baronial Herald:

The courts were heralded by Maister Colyne Stewart, assisted by Dame Siglinde Harfnerstochter, who translated the proceedings into French.

Notes: Court was held in three parts. The first part took part during morning kingdom court, the second was an impromptu "speed court" that occurred in the front vestibule of the site during the early afternoon, while the third part occurred during evening kingdom court.

The majority of the baronial courts (including all scroll wordings) were translated into French by Dame Siglinde.

Three items were deferred to Practicum 2023.

MORNING COURT

Item: Avelyn of Wexcombe and Dafydd ap Alan, Friends of the Hare

Their former Excellencies of Skraeling Althing were named as Friends of the Hare. As they were not in attendance, their scrolls were collected by HE Penn of Ramshaven. Scrolls illuminated and calligraphy done by Giana Gabriella di Milano, wording by Colyne Stewart.

Item: Isabell Atwyll and Amelius Claudius Brittanicus, passports

TEs Skraeling Althing presented Isabell (in absentia) and Rattanicus with passpoorts of safe travel through Their barony. Scolls by an unknown illuminator and calligrapher, wording by TEs Dubhessa and Joffr with Colyne Stewart.

Item: Isabel Atwyll, Friend of the Hare Isabel was named a Friend of the Hare. As she was not in attendance her scroll was collected by Rattanicus. Scolls by an unknown illuminator and calligra-

pher, wording by TEs Dubhessa and Joffr with Colyne Stewart.

Item: Eluned ferch Angor, Black Hare Eluned was given an Award of the Black Hare for being an "instigator" of the arts and sciences. Scroll illuminated and calligraphy by Dame Siglinde Harfnerstochter, wording by Colyne Stewart.

Dame Marguerite was added to the Order of the Hare
Salient for her varied service to the barony. Scroll
(which was in the form of a painting) by Elsebeth
Ffaryn, wording by Colyne Stewart.

EVENING COURT

Item: Gift for Their Excellencies Ile Dragon Dormant

Count Ozurr of the East Kingdom was given a gift of friendship by Their Excellencies Skraeling Althing to be delivered to TEs IDD.

Item: Great Chalice of Skraeling Althing HE Þorfinna gráfeldr was called into court to pass the Great Chalice onto its new holder HE Lucia de Enzinas.

Item: Baronial Taxes

His Excellency announced that this year's taxes were for people to lend assistance to their local chatelaines.

Item: Bunny Tails

William of Wheaton, Kieva Macleod of the Clan Macleod, Elyscia Valliere and Raoul Valliere were presented with Bunny Tails.

Item: Duncan MacLeod, Hare Salient Duncan was added to the Order of the Hare Salient for his service as archery champion, archery marshal,

and siege engine operator. Scroll illuminated by Þorfinna gráf, calligraphy by Nicola Canis, wording by Colyne Stewart.

Item: Pesha of Little Egypt, Hare Salient Pesha was also inducted into the Order of the Hare Salient for her service in offering hospitality to newcomers. Scroll illumination and calligraphy by Breyla la Vienette, wording by James Edgarson.

Item: Helen of Greyfells, Hare Argent Helen of Greyfells was inducted into the Order of the Hare Argent for her long service to the barony. Scroll illuminated by Anon., calligraphy by Giana Gabtiella di Milano, wording by Colyne Stewart.


